

Explanation Of Benefits

Whenever the dental office bills an insurance company for a procedure for a patient, the insurance company sends the dental office and the patient an Explanation of Benefits (EOB).

Each insurance company's EOB look different but typically have the following information:



- 1) Dental Code Billed and What Insurance Paid On
- 2) Date of Service Procedure Was Done
- 3) Explanation of the Service Done
- 4) The Dollar Amount Submitted for Procedure and The Eligible Amount
- 5) The Amount the Insurance Will Pay
- 6) Remark Code Number associated with Note Listed Below to Explain Coverage
- 7) Minus Deductible If the Patient Has Not Paid the Deductible It Would Be Deducted Here
- 8) Remaining Charge What is Remaining After Deductible Paid at Allowed Percentage
