

We do many things to promote optimal dialysis and transplant care-

- Provide information on kidney failure (often called end-stage renal disease or ESRD), patient care, treatment options and services
- Help with patient concerns and complaints
- Work with dialysis providers to improve quality of care
- Collect data for CMS (Centers for Medicare and Medicaid)

- A private talk- you just want to talk with someone about your concerns.

- Information on who to contact- you have a concern about your insurance, doctor, etc. We will refer you to the best agency to help.
