


Career Goals


Learning Style, Continued

Education/General Training

- The degree level that most people would benefit from in order to become an administrative assistant would be to earn an associate's or bachelor's degree. Some colleges offer bachelor's degree programs in business administration, which are 4-year programs that prepare students for secretarial careers with corporations and businesses.
- Office administration training programs are available at community colleges and vocational schools. These courses may take up to one year, and can prepare someone for entry-level employment in the occupation. Some of the courses may include word processing, keyboarding and office applications.
- Someone wanting to pursue a bachelor's degree as an administrative assistant would pursue a major in business administration that would prepare students for secretarial careers with corporations and businesses. Although I could do well with an associates degree in my career choice, I might consider continuing my education at another institution such as Phoenix University online, because I would still have to work fulltime to support myself. The major I would get a degree in would be Business Administration.

Institution


