Kitchen Remodel –

CCC is still leaning towards "no" on a dishwasher. It would need its own waste drain.

Fundraising – I don't know what the exact amount was that we had raised at the time of this meeting. Does anybody have this in their notes?

We think we need a logo for CCC. I'm thinking it could just be a pic of me winking and giving a thumbs up. I'll start campaigning for this soon.

We discussed the possibility of serving school lunch from the new kitchen.

Liz did call 3 places to see if they would sell tickets and we collected cool items for an intermission raffle and baked goodies for the concert.
