If you wish to make reservations for park fireplaces and tables, you are asked to follow this procedure: (1) Phone Richland 411, and determine whether facilities are available for the time you have in mind; (2) Call at Richland Housing Headquarters and secure your written permit to use the facilities during the hours specified. Groups making use of park fireplaces and tables will be expected to have permits in their possession. There is no charge in connection with the issuance of permits. Each reservation will be issued with the understanding that park rules are to be observed, and that all waste paper and refuse will be placed in the trash cans provided be-fore the group leaves the park.

### WARN AGAINST SAFETY HAZARDS FOR CHILDREN IN VILLAGE
