LAWNS AND SHADE TREES NEED AMPLE WATER NOW

While this is not an ideal season for planting lawns, they may be started successfully if given proper care and kept moist at all times, according to the Grounds Section. It is pointed out that the most important consideration is frequent sprinkling, since the young grass plants will become parched and die if the top soil is allowed to remain dry for even a few hours.

The Grounds Section also re-emphasizes the urgency of thoroughly irrigating shade trees in the Village. Where trees have been surrounded by circular dikes to form water saucers, the dikes should be six inches in height, at a radius of eight feet from the tree trunk. This saucer should be half filled with water, and the faucet then turned back so that a flow will continue into the saucer at the same rate that the water is absorbed by the soil. It is recommended that this be done for eight hour periods twice weekly.

Signs are being posted in the "Village Orchards" which are open to residents. Care should be used in picking so that the branches of the trees will not be injured.
