J. KENNETH PEARCE TO SPEAK

ON "INDIA THE ENIGMA"

On Tuesday, April 18, at 8:30 P.M., Professor J. Kenneth Pearce will address one of the Community Forums being held in the Village of Richland under the supervision of School District No. 400, and the United Protestant Church, in cooperation with the University of Washington. He will speak on "India the Enigma".

Professor Pearce is an authority on his subject, having spent ten years in the service of the Government of India, as logging engineer and chief forest engineer. He has a background of personal acquaintance with the people of India, ranging from maharajahs and political leaders to jungle aborigines. In 1942, the War Production Board called him to Washington, D. C., to organize the unit in charge of lumber production problems in the thirteen western states. He headed this group until his return to the University of Washington last autumn. Professor Pearce has served as a consulting logging engineer in the Pacific Northwest, and has studied forest operations in eleven different countries.

DANGERS OF CHILDREN FLYING KITES NEAR ELECTRIC LINES

Children have been observed flying kites in the residential sections of Richland Village. Due to the many electric lines serving the different houses, kites or strings may come in contact with the electric wires. This could result in severe shock and possibly death of the child flying the kite, especially when the kite string is wet.

Parents who permit their children to fly kites should make sure that the children go to an open area, away from any residential section, and away from all electric wires.
