

MEDICAL SERVICE AVAILABLE AT FIRST AID STATION

The Medical Department announces that medical service for Richland residents is available at all times at Richland First Aid. The station is located about halfway along the street running west from the Transient Quarters to the Main Office Building.

Visits to First Aid should be made in all cases where the patient's condition permits, since facilities for better care are available there.

Requests for emergency or other necessary visits to the home should be made by phoning the First Aid Station -- Richland 300 -- day or night.

The following charges are made for medical service:

Office Calls - Richland First Aid - \$1.25 plus cost of medicine or any special treatment prescribed.

Home Calls - 7:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. - \$2.00

11:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M. - \$4.00

The payment for First Aid medical calls will be made to the First Aid cashier at the time of the visit. Fees for home calls will be paid to the Doctor, who will issue a receipt to the patient.

A public health nurse is on duty at Richland First Aid between 8:00 A.M. and 5:30 P.M. This nurse should be contacted in all cases of contagious diseases, such as measles, mumps, scarlet fever, etc. She will advise as to proper isolation and management.

Additional information concerning medical and hospital services will be published at intervals.

DRIVEWAYS AND PARKING COMPOUNDS ARE NOT THOROUGHFARES!

Please read this BEFORE you run over a child.---

Since the parking compounds in the Village have entrances from two parallel streets, a few drivers of automobiles and trucks have been observed using these driveways as cross streets or short cuts, rather than continuing around the block on the regular streets. This is a very dangerous practice which must be discontinued immediately. Children playing in their back yards frequently run across the driveways leading to the parking compounds. Certainly, those who drive cars and trucks don't want to risk running over a child just to save driving half a block.

Persons using the compounds for parking should be extremely careful and drive under 10 miles per hour while entering or leaving the compounds.
