### VICTORY GARDENS TO BE ASSIGNED

Assignment of first Victory Garden plots will begin early next week. Assignments will be made according to the order in which applications were received; and plots will be allocated as rapidly as they can be made ready for use. Victory Garden plots will be located at the northwest corner of the Village in the area north of Symons Street and west of Thayer Drive.

If you have made application, information regarding your assigned plot and its location will be delivered to your home, making it unnecessary for you to contact anyone in Richland Housing, which is handling the project. You will also be supplied with a bulletin issued by the Extension Service of Washington State College, containing valuable information on gardening in this locality. If you have not made application for a Victory Garden plot, you may do so by calling at the Tenant Service, Richland Housing, in Building 713.
