## COOPERATION ASKED IN USE OF LAWN MOWERS

At the present time there is a very limited number of lawn mowers available for use by Village residents. These mowers are housed in the office of the Shift Superintendent - Special Construction, located just west of Richland Park. Since transportation is not now available for delivery of these mowers to individual homes on a loan basis, residents are asked to call for the machines when they are needed and to return them to the office as soon as possible.

Because of the limited number of lawn mowers, all borrowed machines must be returned not later than two days after they are checked out, if all residents are to have an opportunity to make use of them. When additional mowers are secured, it is planned to assign machines permanently to designated groups of homes.
