SHADE TREES REQUIRE SYSTEMATIC WATERING

If you have any shade trees around your house they will probably be getting thirsty very soon.

Trees are not likely to survive in this area unless they are provided with regular applications of water at two week intervals during the summer.

Watering is best accomplished by forming a saucer around the base of the tree with a four inch ridge of soil. This dike or ridge should be constructed in the form of a circle, corresponding with the outer tips of the lower branches, since trees do most of their feeding from small roots located out a distance from the trunk equal to the spread of the bottom branches. Water is then applied to the saucer thus formed. The soil used to make the dike should be taken from outside the circle rather than next to the tree.

A comparatively heavy application of water is preferred rather than several light sprinklings.

The irrigation system which originally supplied these trees with water was broken during construction so that the care of these trees will fall upon the individual tenant this year.
