GEORGE WASHINGTON WAY TO BE CLOSED DURING CONSTRUCTION

The office of the Division Engineer has announced that reconstruction of George Washington Way will require barricading of various sections of this road during the next few weeks. This week, barricades were placed at the intersection of George Washington Way and Swift Boulevard and at the intersection of George Washington Way with the extension of Stevens Drive just south of the 300 Area. Reconstruction work is being carried forward from a point opposite the north end of Division 3 to the Yakima River bridge.

Traffic bound for Hanford will go west on Swift Boulevard to Stevens Drive and thence north on Stevens. Access to Division 3 will be available via Symons Street, Van Giesen Street, and the extension of Hunt Point Loop. Persons outside Division 3 affected by the barricade may use any of the gravel roads leading to the east from Stevens Drive, north of Division 3.
