IMPORTANT — POWER SHUT-DOWN TOMORROW!!!

There will be a power shut-down tomorrow, Sunday, February 6, 1944, in the Richland Area between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m., inclusive and 4:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. inclusive. It is earnestly requested that you follow the same procedure during these shut-downs as have been followed during shut-downs in the past, that is, be sure all light, stove and appliance switches are turned to the "off" position for the duration of the shut-down. Do not use hot water unless absolutely necessary. Your compliance with this request will prevent overloads and unnecessary trouble and repairs.
