## Important Notice!

### TWO POWER SHUTDOWNS SUNDAY

There will be a complete power shutdown in the Richland area during two periods on Sunday, April 23--from 9:00 A.M. to 10:30 A.M., and from 4:00 P.M. to 5:30 P.M.

All residents of the area are requested to turn off all light switches and all switches on ranges and other electric fixtures during the shutdown periods.

You are also asked to use no water during the periods unless absolutely necessary, to conserve the supply for necessary fire protection.

Observance of these instructions will help to avoid a sudden overload, which could cause damage to transformers and delay normal resumption of electric service.

Remember the shutdown periods. 9:00--10:30 A.M. and 4:00--5:30 P.M.

Due to the shutdown, the Richland Theatre has announced that there will be only one matinee on Sunday, starting at 1:00 P.M. Showings will resume at 5:45 P.M., and there will be three complete evening shows.

The Cafeteria will open at the usual time Sunday morning and close at 2:00 P.M. It will re-open at 5:30 P.M. instead of 4:00 P.M.

### POST OFFICE IN NEW LOCATION

#### STARTING MONDAY, APRIL 24

Effective Monday, April 24, the Richland Post Office will be open in its new location, approximately two blocks north of the present site.

Postmaster E. C. Peddicord has announced that opening and closing hours will remain the **same** as at present.

The office opens each day, except Sunday, at 9:15 A.M. From Monday through Friday the closing hour is 6:00 P.M.; on Saturdays the office closes at 5:00 P.M.

Installation of lock boxes is underway but will not be completed for some time. Boxes will be assigned in the order in which requests are received. Residents desiring to rent boxes should apply at the General Delivery Window.
