A "MAJOR MOMENT" FOR FIRST 5



The First 5 app just surpassed a huge milestone: In less than 3 years, more than 2 million users have downloaded the app to transform their time with God. P31 launched First 5 in July 2015 to aid in its vision to eradicate biblical poverty. The goal of the app is to encourage readers to spend the first 5 minutes of their day in God's Word.

Director of Theology Joel Muddamalle said, "It's a humbling reality that we get to create studies for books [of the Bible] and see the transformative power of the gospel." One First 5 user shared the life-changing impact the app has had on her family:

"I wanted to say thank you for the First 5 app. I read it every morning, and I've started sending some of the teachings to my mom and dad each day. My dad was recently diagnosed with cancer. I grew up attending church, but I knew my dad was far from God. For many years, I've prayed that God would open his eyes and his heart. Since his cancer diagnosis I've shared devotional readings with him and my mom each morning. I never knew if my dad read them, but I kept sending them anyway. Recently I got a text from my dad telling me he actually was reading them, and they're giving them a lot to think about and contemplate. So, I just wanted to say thank you, from the bottom of my heart, for helping my dad get to know Jesus and for sparking a huge change in my family. I am forever grateful!"

With the completion of the most recent study, Return to Refuge, which highlighted the books of Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah and Malachi — First 5 has taken readers on a journey through the Bible spanning 50 books of the Old and New Testaments. The next study, beginning July 2, will delve into the book of John for a second time.
