# Enterprise Incident Management System (EIM) May 2017 EIM Release Training Materials and Q&A Sessions

**PURPOSE:** The Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) will be offering training materials

and question and answer sessions related to changes in the Enterprise Incident

Management System (EIM) that are to be released May 20th 2017.

# **BACKGROUND-SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

#### **EIM System Changes**

- 1. Restraint Incident Reports
  - a. The text field titled "Restraint Agent/Technique" has become mandatory for all restraint incident reports.
  - b. The warning message "Warning: A restraint incident report is required to be submitted and linked to this incident" is retired
  - c. The warning message "Warning: An Abuse-Improper or Unauthorized Use of Restraint incident report must be filed and linked to this restraint report" is modified
  - d. Alerts have been added related to Restraint incident reports
- 2. Death Incident Reports
  - a. Users will have the ability to select from four new secondary categories when entering a Death incident report

- b. Removal of the question "Was there a hospitalization for this individual?" from the Death information page of the incident report
- 3. Enhancement of Corrective Action Data Entry Ability via the Addition of Preventative Corrective Action Page to Incident Reports
  - a. Each <u>confirmed</u> incident of Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation must have a remediation action that shows evidence of prevention of future recurrence
  - b. The Preventative Corrective Action page of the incident report allows for documentation of a corrective action that provides evidence of remediation that protects participants from future incidents
- 4. Change in Functionality to Allow Users to More Effectively Manage incidents of Abuse and Neglect
  - a. The question "As a result of the investigation is this a case of founded Abuse or Neglect" is being removed
  - b. Access to the Hospitalization Page within Abuse Neglect and Individual to Individual Abuse reports has been added
- 5. Additional Changes
  - a. The output for the EIM Custom Report will now be in a static, alphabetic, order
  - b. Users will be able to view the reason for incident deletion
  - c. Users with the appropriate access will be able to view the entire incident history for an individual

#### **DISCUSSION**

Self-guided training materials for each of the five topics above have been developed and posted to the Learning Management System (LMS). Users are encouraged to review the materials and participate in the Q&A sessions. ODP staff will be available during the Q&A to answer questions and provide clarifications to stakeholders.
