U.S. Government Bonds Rebound on Election Uncertainty

Traders say the bond market may be vulnerable to price swings as investors gird for several big events

Growing anxiety over the U.S. presidential election stoked demand for haven bonds, pushing up prices of U.S. government bonds after an earlier bout of declines.
