Parts Included with the PERRIN Dual Slip-On Tips:

- (1) 4" Dual Wall Tip
- (1) 225 PERRIN T-bolt Clamp



Installation:

- 1) Remove OEM tip from exhaust using 10mm ratchet or wrench. NOTE: This could be difficult if tip is slightly corroded and stuck on exhaust. The use of penetrating oil may be necessary.
- 2) Slide PERRIN tip over exhaust pipe.
- 3) Adjust tip to desired location and tighten clamp just enough until tip cannot be rotated or move anymore. NOTE: Over tightening of tip can result in crushing of the tube making it very hard to remove.
- Take car for test drive and recheck tip for tightness after roughly 30 minutes of drive time.
