#### **SPECIAL NOTES:**

- A slight increase to NVH (Noise, Vibration, and Harshness) is normal to find after installing this part.
- If the bearing on your driveshaft (not the rubber surround but the bearing inside of the rubber) is bad, a new driveshaft is recommended as the PERRIN driveshaft lock down will accentuate the noise from the bad bearing.





## Installation of PERRIN Driveshaft Lockdown

- 1. Raise vehicle off ground using vehicle hoist or proper jack and jack stands. Never support vehicle with jack as death or injury may occur.
- For BRZ/FR-S/86 models, skip this step. For all other models, locate (6) M8 bolts and remove exhaust heat shield from car. NOTE:
   Removing this can be done with the OEM exhaust in place but it can be tight pulling it out. It will require minor bending of the shield to get it out but can be bent back into place during reinstallation.




- 3. Remove (2) M10 bolts securing center driveshaft support to chassis and let driveshaft rest on the exhaust system.
- 4. Apply a small amount of grease to the rubber flange on the OEM driveshaft carrier on both front and back sides. **NOTE: The areas that should be greased are where the PERRIN Driveshaft Lockdown touches.**



- 5. Install Front Driveshaft Lockdown (part with through holes not the part with threads) onto the front carrier housing making sure to place open area toward the chassis. NOTE: BRZ/FR-S/86 customers will find a tight fit between the flanges. A little push or a tap with a hammer will allow this to "pop" over the hump to allow it to fit on.
- 6. Install Rear Driveshaft Lockdown (part with threads) to the rear of the OEM driveshaft carrier and then install supplied M8 bolts loosely into all 4 holes. NOTE: Some rotation of both parts may be necessary to get bolts to line up with holes and make sure that lower left bolt passes through small triangular opening in OEM carrier.



- 7. Hand tighten bolts in a crisscross pattern until both front and rear lockdowns are touching the OEM carrier bearing housing. Then torque bolts to 8-10ft-lbs (96-120in-lbs).
- 8. Install supplied washer between carrier bearing mount and chassis, then install M10 bolts removed earlier and tighten them to 38 ft-lbs. NOTE: Before final tightening, verify that PERRIN Driveshaft Lockdown is centered in the driveshaft tunnel. There is enough slop in the bolts and bushings that some centering of parts can be done by loosening bolts and retightening them.



- 9. Grab driveshaft and give it a good shake up and down to center it within the carrier bearing.
- 10. Reinstall exhaust heat shield and tighten M8 bolts to 8 ft-lbs.
- 11. Take car for test drive and verify there are no clunking noises or abnormal sounds. When installed properly, there should not be any extreme vibration felt. Re-check the installation and re-test.
