SPECIAL NOTES:


• A slight increase in NVH (Noise, Vibration and Harshness) will be noticed after the installation. This is due to the stiffer nature of the connection of the rear subframe to the chassis. This is completely normal and not something to be concerned with. Clunking of rear suspension is not normal and if found, checking of all bolts for tightness may be necessary.




Installation Of Rear Differential Support Bushings

- 1. Park car on a smooth level surface. Using a suitable commercial hoist or jack, raise car and support on jack stands remove rear wheels.
- Support rear differential using jack or adjustable stand. Remove two nuts securing differential stabilizer to differential. Using stud removal tool, or Jam nut technique, remove studs from rear differential cover.
- 3. Remove two bolts and nuts securing differential stabilizer to rear subframe. Lower differential slightly to allow for clearance to remove bolts.



- 4. Remove differential stabilizer from sub frame, then install (4) smaller red urethane bushings around the inside of the OEM bushings. There are (2) bushings that go on each side of each bushing.
- 5. Reinstall differential support brace into chassis using bolts to hold in place and leave bolts loose.
- 6. Raise differential back into car, line up stud holes with differential support holes and reinstall studs.
- 7. Tighten differential stabilizer support bolts to 70ft-lbs. Tighten nuts on studs protruding through sub frame to 70 ft-lbs.
- 8. Locate differential front support beam and the (2) outer bolts securing it to chassis.
- 9. Remove passenger side large bolt securing front support beam to chassis, and two bolts securing plate to chassis.



- 10. Pull down front support brace until enough room is made to place bushings on top of OEM bushings. (Note: make sure to leave round steel plate on chassis with small tabs facing down)
- 11. Reinstall plate back onto chassis and tighten bolts to 25ft-lbs.
- 12. Install large bolt through bushing and tighten to 100ft-lbs.
- 13. Repeat this process on the driver's side of car.
- 14. Lower jack from differential, then remove car from jack stands and take for a test drive. Ensure that no clunking is heard during the test drive. If clunking is heard, recheck the entire installation. If further clunking is heard, please contact the tech department.
