
Installation:

- 1. Open trunk of vehicle, remove carpet and locate rear shock towers located under the felt trunk liner flaps on both sides of the car.
- 2. Lift up flaps and remove (4) M10 nuts securing the shocks to the chassis. NOTE: Do not raise the car off the ground after removing nuts!



- 3. Loosely assemble Rear Shock Tower Brace outside of car:
 - a. Set both feet down, then set bar into feet.
 - b. Install supplied caps onto feet using supplied M6 bolts. Leave bolts loose at this time.

- 4. Place assembled shock tower bar onto shock studs. NOTE: Some alignment of bar and feet will need to occur to get all (4) holes to line up to the studs.
- 5. Reinstall carpet under bar, then tighten all (4) M10 nuts to 22ft-lbs, then tighten M6 bolts on caps to 5-8ft-lbs to secure.
- 6. Take vehicle for test drive and then recheck hardware to make sure nothing came loose.



Trunk Liner Trimming

There are a couple of options for how to deal with the trunk liners after installing the PERRIN Rear Shock Tower Bar. For cutting, we recommend an X-acto knife or utility type scissors (like kitchen shears).

Option #1: Leave the flaps resting on the bar and feet. Just be aware that over time the trunk panels may change the finish of part as they move and vibrate.

Option #2: Cut a large opening to allow the bar and feet to pass through the side panels. Take your time by cutting a small slit where the bar passes through then slowly open it up until the desired shape is had.

Option #3: Cut a slit that allows the bar to pass through but leave the side panels long enough to fold under the bar and feel. This method will have the best looking outcome if done properly. Again, take time and start with small cuts.
