SUSPENSION INSTALLATION NOTE






Installation of PERRIN Front Swaybar

- 1. Using a professional vehicle hoist, or proper jack and jack stands, raise vehicle off the ground. The vehicle's weight must be supported by jack stands. Death or serious injury could result from an improperly supported vehicle.
- 2. Using panel removal tool or flat head screwdriver, locate and remove (3) plastic fasteners in each wheel well as shown above.

3. Using proper panel removal tool or flat head screwdriver, locate and remove (9) plastic fasteners and (2) 12mm headed bolts from lower portion of splash guard as shown above.



- 4. Locate and remove (4) M8 bolts securing black steel skid plate from chassis and set skid plate aside.
- 5. Locate and remove (2) M12 nuts securing endlinks to swaybar. Then remove (2) M8 nuts and (2) M8 bolts securing swaybar bushing brackets to chassis. The swaybar will now be loose from the vehicle, but it will not fall from the car.



Locate and remove (2) M12 nuts securing engine mounts to the subframe. Using a jack or proper adjustable jackstand, lift engine up about 1/2" or more to allow swaybar to fit between the subframe and engine.



- Remove the swaybar from the chassis. NOTE: This will take some maneuvering to get bar from the car. IF working on the ground, removing part of the exhaust system can make this job a lot easier.
- 8. Reinstall PERRIN Swaybar into the chassis the opposite way the OEM part was removed, then temporarily connect swaybar to both endlinks to hold in place. Carefully lower engine down while making sure to NOT pinch swaybar between subframe and engine. Tighten both nuts securing motor mount to chassis to 66ft-lbs.
- 9. Apply grease to the inside of each swaybar bushing, then install each bushing onto the swaybar. Spin bushing around bar to spread the grease out evenly. **NOTE: Use roughly half of the grease on each bushing and/or directly to the swaybar.**
- 10. Install both swaybar brackets and use hardware removed previously to secure. Tighten bolts and nuts to 18ft-lbs.



- 11. Determine which hole to mount the endlinks to by using the picture below. Closer to the swaybar pivot is the stiffer setting. Tighten both nuts to 45ft-lbs. NOTE: You can install one endlink connected to the front hole on one side and the rear hole on the other to have a middle setting.
- 12. Reinstall all the following items you removed in earlier steps:
 - a. Reinstall (4) bolts holding steel skid plate to sub frame. (Torque bolts to 18.4 ft-lbs)
 - o. Reinstall plastic splash guard and all plastic fasteners. Tighten M8 bolts to 13.3 ft-lbs.
- 13. Lower car from jack stands and take for a test drive. Ensure that no clunking is heard during the test drive. If clunking is heard, recheck the entire installation. If further clunking is heard, please contact the tech department.
