Under separate cover I am sending you a history of Flippen church, completed in 1952. I sent Brother A. M. Pierce a copy at that time, but send you this copy with a few corrections and some additions of pastors.

Our pastor carried the card filled out to the Dist. Con. at Jackson. In 1959 we completed a new building program, consisting of a two story wing and large basement, for educational and social purposes.

Also, in 1959 we built a new parsonage and furnished it nicely. Parsonage is on church lot. Cost for this was \$55,000. Much was donated, or cost would have been much greater.

Dr. Pierce directed me to the old minutes in the Theological Library at Emory. From there I went to the

later minutes in the vault at Wesley
Memorial church.

indeed a labor of love.

I have been a member of the Methodist
Church for seventy years, being now
in my eighty first year.
