The following is the history of Fullers Chapel church, Dalton District, N. Ga. Conf. I am sorry it is not as complete as we both would like, however you must realize how hard it is to gather information from so long ago.

Fullers Chapel, which is located in Murray County, had its beginning in an old school house in 1885. Cardan school building was used until 1893 when a new church was built at its present location. The church was named after a retired Methodist Minister and Presiding Elder, Dr. Fuller. The first minister was named Truman.

The present church was built under Rev. Riddley 44 years ago in the same location as the first church. A parsonage was also built a few years later.

Fullers church was a member of the Northern Methodist Episcapal Church until unification in 1939.

Since that time Fullers has been part of the Spring Place Circuit, and seven years ago was placed on the Dalton Circuit. The church at the present time has 65 members with Mr. and Mrs. W. C. Iotspeich being members for the longest period of time.
