Organization: This Church was organized in 1875, the following
being among its earliest trustees: A. L. Gaither, W. H. Gaither,
Milton Harris, Watt Griffin, Hugh Hargrove. The deed is recorded
in Covington, Newton County Court House, as of 1878.
The Quarterly Conference Records are not protected against loss or
fire.
Events: This church also served as a public school up until 1894.
Building: A building program was begun in 1960 which has completely
renovated all the original structure. Sunday School Classrooms
have been added (3), and the church is now in good condition.
