HISTORY OF MOUNT PISCAH METHODIST CHURCH

The actual records of Mount Pisgah's history were burned in the Alpharetta court house during the 1860's. This information was compiled from the older Church members.

The oldest known date of the original Church goes back to 1831. The Church was stationed at the crossroads of Jones Bridge Road and Old Alabama Road, now occupied by Pleasant Hill Baptist Church. The original Church building had hewed sills, morticed and pinned together with hand made wooden pegs. During the decade of 1860 the Church was moved to the present location on Nesbit Ferry Road. The land totaling 40 acres was donated by "Uncle Billy" Tribble. Later, part (about half) of the land was sold to make Church repairs.

Between the years of 1870 and 1875 a camp ground was built behind the Church, and continued to the late 1890's. Through these years an annual revival was held in the arbor every summer. After this time several tent meetings were held with considerable success. In 1908, E. M. Staunton held one with 50 additions to the church on profession of faith, and in 1934, Marvin Williams held on with 27 converts.

In 1941 the present building was built under the ministry of Frank Moorhead. The plans for the Church were drawn by Mr. E. C. Chamblee, Sr. one of the members. Mr. R. C. Nesbit broke the ground.

Until 1955 the church remained on a circuit, but in that year under the ministry of J.R. McGhey it became a station.

Some of the preachers that came our of Mount Pisgah are Harvey Smith, Will Smith, Bill Smith, Johnny Harris, and Tommy Manell. The first three were Methodist and the last two were holliness.
