Mt. Vernon Church History

Many years ago little bands of Methodists from Dunnegan, Lucens and Rocky Face communities united their talents and gifts to purchase a wooded lot at Mt. Vernon and build a church there. This land was acquired from a Presbyterian group whose church had burned.

In 1876 a one room church was built of sturdy lumber that stood the test of time and witnessed many happy and sad meetings of the people. The older folks remember the ministry of Rev. Whitfield, Allday, Richardson Eades and many others. Almost everyone remembers Mr. Hessler, the Sunday School superintendent for forty two or three years prior to his death. Every Sunday, rain or shine summer or winter he was at his church to worship God. How well all remember his willing and faithful service! If the workers were all absent he built the fire, played the organ, led the singing, read the scripture

prayed and taught the class. His example is a challenge to all to do as well. His picture hangs on the east wall of the present church to remind Christians to be faithful.

In 1948 under the ministry of Rev. Julius Orr, plans were made for building a new church. By faith the work was started and God's blessing rested upon it. Generous gifts of money, material and labor poured in from friends and members. In 1949, the brick edifice consisting of furnished auditorium, four class rooms and choir all heated by gas was completed, free of debt.

The first services were held in Dec. 1949. Thankful and happy hearts made up the congregation that day. Many worship services have followed. This church welcomes all who come. The pastor, Rev. Paul Stone urges all to, "Serve the Lord with gladness".
