

History of Pleasant Hill Methodist Church

Pleasant Hill Methodist Church received two acres of land on September 16, 1953 given by Jarrett Thomas. The deed was from Jarrett Thomas to Jonathan Ball, George Letson, W. P. Spruce, R. W. Brown, Jordon Bridges, James Harper and David Letson, trustees of this church.

The Church is located on Highway # 36 between Jackson and Barnesville, Georgia at The Highfalls Road.

The present building was the first one built. It has been remodeled. The interior of the Church was completely renovated in July and August of 1949.

School was taught in the Church until about 1883 or 1884. A small school building was erected about this time in which school was held a number of years.

During this time the Church has been served from the following charges or circuits: Milner, Barnesville, Forsyth, Griffin, and Jenkinsburg.
