Welcome Methodist Church was organized and erected in the year of 1920.

The land, one and one half acres was given by B.F.Roop. The church is located two and a half miles southwest of Roopville.

Brother B.F. Woodruff was largely responsible for the building. Free labor and donations in cash erected the church.

The charter members were W.S.Shirey, L.L.Deming, J.W.Gentry, P.W.Crockett, T.C.Johnson, L.B.Neighbors, L.J.Craven, S.J.Craven, Lynn Ragland, Cliff Ragland, Mrs. L.L.Deming was the first church member.

The trustees were W.S.Shirey, J.W.Gentry, and L.J.Craven.

The dedication sermon was preached by Rev. Dillard in 1920.

Mrs. Ida Shirey was the first person buried at the church semetery on February 4,1923.

Welsome Church has kept up a regular Sunday school attendance ever since the church was built.

Welcome Methodist Church was organized in 1920 and the Church erected. The land, one and a half acres was given by B.F.Roop. The Church is lacated two and one half miles southwest of Roopville. Rev.W.F.Woodruff is largely responsible for the building enterprise. Free labor and donations of cash was used in erecting the church.

The charter members were W.S.Shirey, L.L.Deming, J.W.Gentry, P.W.Crockett, T.C.Johnson, L.B.Neighbors, L.J.Craven, S.J.Craven, Lynn Ragland, Cliff England. Mrs. L.L.Deming was the first church member. The first Trustees were W.S.Shirey, J.W.Gentry, and L.J.Craven. The dedication sermon was preached by Rev.Walter B.Dillard in 1920.

Mrs. Ida Shirey was the first person buried in the cemetery on Feb.4, 1923. Welcome Church was first on the Roopville Circuit, OF THE Rome District, 1920 - 1912 when the Roopville Charge was transferred to the LaGrange District. Welcome remained a part of the Roopville Circuit till 1951 when it became a part of the Unity Circuit.
