**Introduction**

Pacific Northwest Publishing, Inc. ("**we**" or "**us**" or "**our**") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy.

This policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website [www.safeandcivilsurvey.net](http://www.safeandcivilsurvey.net) (the "**Website**") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

**This Website is for use by persons who live in the United States. We do not warrant that this Website is appropriate or authorized for us in any other country. If you live outside of the United States, you are responsible for determining whether this Privacy Policy and the rest of the Website comply with the laws that apply to you. If this Privacy Policy and the rest of the Website do not comply with the laws that apply to you, you must not access or use the Website.**

This policy applies to information we collect:

- On the Website.

Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use the Website. By accessing or using the Website, you agree to this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy may change from time to time (see Changes to our Privacy Policy). Your continued use of the Website after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check the Privacy Policy periodically for updates.

**Children Under the Age of 13**

The Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 and its rules (collectively, "COPPA") require us to inform parents and legal guardians (as used in this section, "**parents**") about our practices for collecting, using, and disclosing personal information from children under the age of 13 ("**children**"). It also requires us to obtain verifiable consent from a child's parent for certain collection, use, and disclosure of the child's personal information.

This section notifies parents of:

- The types of information we may collect from children.

- How we use the information we collect.
- Our practices for disclosing that information.
- All operators that collect or maintain information from children through this Website

This section applies only to children under the age of 13 and supplements the other provisions of this Privacy Policy. Only the other provisions of this Privacy Policy apply to teens and adults.

### **Information We Collect from Children**

Children access the Website and its content and use its features without being required to provide us with any personal information. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If you are under 13, you will not be able to provide any information about yourself to us, including your name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, or any screen name or user name you may use. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information.

**Information We Collect Directly.** We do not require a child to submit any personal information in order to use the Website and its features.

**Automatic Information Collection.** We use technology to temporarily track session-state variable data from our users, including children, when they access and navigate through the Website and use certain of its features. Those data are cleared when the survey is closed or completed. This information cannot identify the child providing information to the Website.

### **How We Use A Child's Information**

We use the nonpersonal information that may be collected from a child to:

- Provide information to their school about school safety, climate, and culture.
- Analyze that information to improve school safety, climate, and culture.

We use the information we collect automatically through technology (see Automatic Information Collection) and other nonpersonal information we collect to associate each of the answers in a particular survey to that survey.

### **Our Practices for Disclosing Children's Information**

We do not collect, share, sell, rent, or transfer children's personal information.

We may disclose aggregated information about many of our users and information that does not identify any individual.

In addition, if Pacific Northwest Publishing, Inc. is involved in a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Pacific Northwest Publishing, Inc.'s assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or a similar proceeding or event, we may transfer the information we have collected or maintain to the buyer or other successor.

### **Accessing and Correcting Your Child's Personal Information**

Because we do not collect any personal information about a child, there is no ability for a parent to be able to access the information provided by that parent's child.

### **Operators That Collect or Maintain Personal Information from Children**

No third-party operators collect or maintain personal information from children through the Website.

### **Data Security**

We and our partners have implemented measures designed to secure your information from accidental loss and from unauthorized access, use, alteration, and disclosure. These include the use of SSL encryption, firewalls, administrative access-level controls, and employee training.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure. Although we do our best to protect your information, we cannot guarantee the security of your information transmitted to our Website, submitted by you, information gathered about you, or information stored by us. Any transmission of information is at your own risk. We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures contained on the Website.
