HOW TO FIND YOUR SISTERS/BEINGS

One of the things we know is that many of you are yearning for more in-person community. We also know, from talking with many of you, that there are fears and or obstacles to finding sisters and/or creating gatherings in your community.

So, I thought I would share this resource.

Imagine us sitting together with a cup of tea and having a quick chat about how to brainstorm beyond obstacles and limitations!

First off, don't assume that there are NOT others in your area feeling the call to the Goddess and may need a bit of support and invite to step out and join you!

A major part of embodying the role of the Priestess is the willingness to shine your light out into the world and aid others in remembering who they are...

Here are some ways to connect with like hearted beings...

Enroll the people you know and love!

- **Your Ceremonial Celebration doesn't need to be BIG** in order to matter. Nix that thought. Maybe start by telling the beings that you already know who would love to be invited even, if it is only 2 or 3!
- **Stretch out of your comfort zone** and ask for support. Have each person you invite share the invitation with another 1-2 people.
- **If you are open to having kids present**, this might increase the appeal! Beltane is especially fun for kids and younger people.

FB: love it or hate it, it is a way that I have found to connect with others

- **Type in the name of your town or city** and you will see ALL groups and events for your area come up on one page! It's a great way to start to get connected; it maybe a stretch outside of your comfort zone, but that is part of this work!
- **Create a FB event for your ceremonial celebration.** Choose a geographical area and make a call out to sisters who maybe local to you.
- **If you are not comfy on social media**, enlist a teenager if you have one around; they swim in this water so easefully!

Make a flier the good, old fashioned way!

- Place fliers in local coffee shops, yoga studios, health food stores, holistic health centers, local gyms, anywhere that people gather and might be interested in this celebration.
- Are there local clubs, meet-ups, social gatherings in your area that you might go to and talk about this event!? This again maybe a stretch and it is part of stepping more into our calling to celebrate!
- Are there any women's circles? Craft circles, dance classes? Is there a community college? Or adult classes where you might post your fliers?

But, I live in a tiny rural area!

I hear you! And I know that this is case for some of you who are part of this temple...

- So, this might be a time to see if there are sisters who are in a nearby, larger town that is within travelling distance to you that you might collaborate with to bring a ceremonial celebration alive. This may feel like a stretch and it is invitation to maybe create connections and web work with those who are like hearted.
- If you don't live near a larger town. Then it maybe that you create a solitary ceremonial celebration - which is just fine...you can choose to connect with the divine and offer your own ritual blessings.
