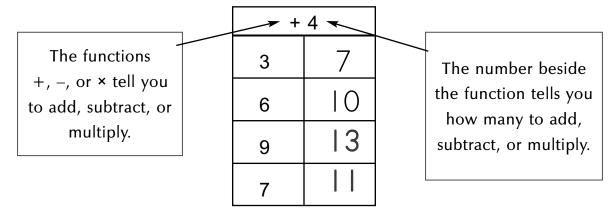

## **Using Function Tables**

Function tables help you do the same thing to many numbers.



This is an addition function table. We add 4 to each number on the left and write the answer in the box on the right.

3 + 4 = 7 Write 7 in the box on the right.

6 + 4 = 10 Write 10 in the box on the right.

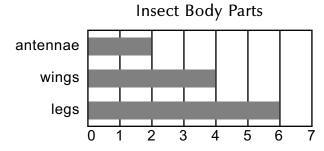
