


# Weather and Seasons

**sunshine** (sən•shīn). the light and heat from the sun

**thermometer** (thər•mō•mē•tər). a tool used to tell how warm or cold the weather is



Say these words to someone.

God sends the **sunshine**. The sunshine is hot. You get very warm when you play in the sunshine. The wind may be cool, but the sunshine feels warm. The sunshine can melt the snow.

Plants need sunshine to grow. We need sunshine too. The sun helps to keep us warm. The sun helps us feel good. It is good to play in the sunshine. Thank You, God, for sunshine.



### Lesson 3

On days with lots of sunshine, there are not many clouds in the sky. But on some days there are many clouds in the sky. Sometimes we can't see the sun because the clouds hide the sun from us.

God sends the clouds. The rain and snow come from clouds. When it is very hot, the clouds can hide the sun and help to keep us cool.






