God made your body. He gave you eyes. He gave you ears. He gave you a nose and a mouth. With your body you can see, hear, smell, and taste.


You can feel things you touch too. You can feel things with your hands and your feet. You can feel things with your skin.







All around you are things to hear. You hear sounds of birds and animals. You hear sounds of people. You hear sounds of cars and trucks.
