Many people live in North America. The people come from many places. Some have dark skin and some have light skin. They do not all like to eat the same things. They do not all live the same way.

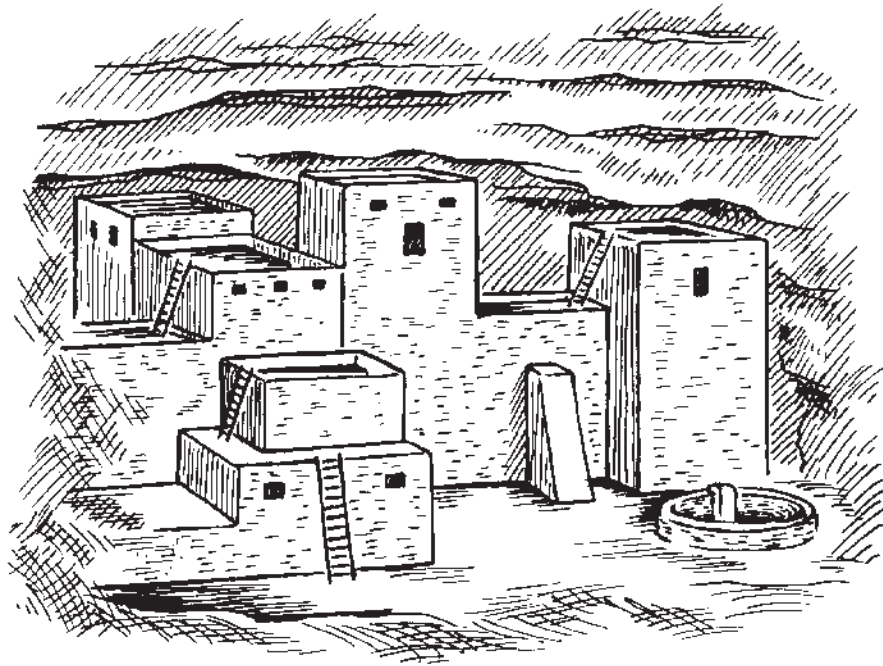


North America is very big. Canada is big. The United States is big. People live in many places in North America. Some places are hot and some are cold. Some places are wet and some are dry.

In many places in North America, you can find people who love God. You can go to church with them. You can worship God together.

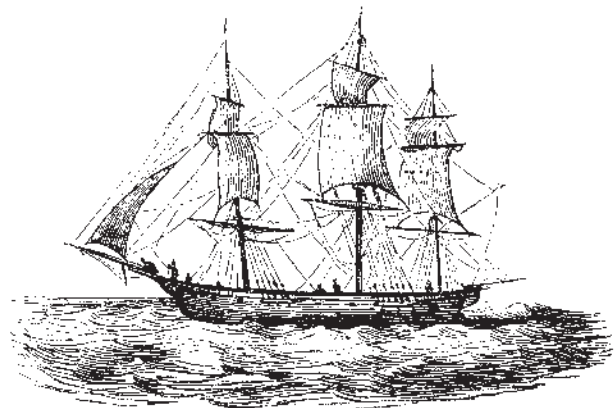
