

## Entry Words

You have learned that guide words at the top of each page help you find words in a dictionary.

**Entry words** are the words that can be looked up in a dictionary. Entry words are usually printed in dark print.

**lamb** (lām) *noun* – 1. a young sheep; 2. its meat.

**lame** (lām) *adjective* – 1. having a hurt leg or foot that causes a limp. 2. stiff and very painful; 3. not good enough.

**lamp** (lāmp) *noun* – a device that gives off light.

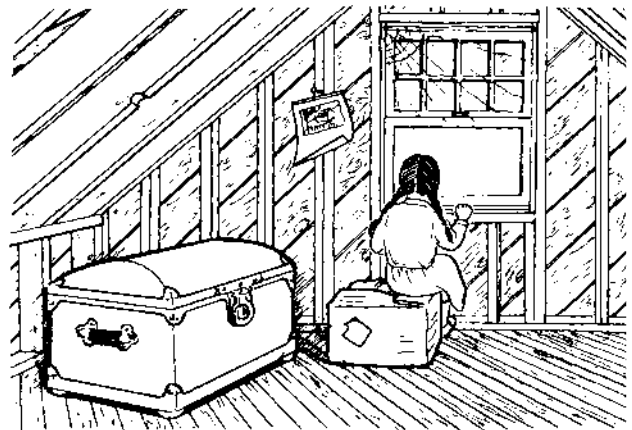

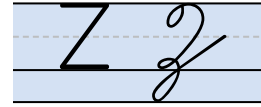
