

Diagramming Sentences

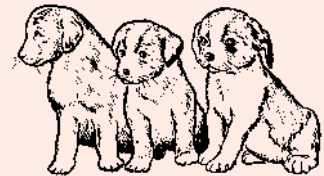
You have learned to write complete sentences. Each word in a sentence does a special job. A **diagram** shows how the parts of a sentence fit together.

A diagram for nouns and verbs looks like this:



The main noun in the sentence is first because it tells what the sentence is about. The verb is after the noun because it tells what the noun did or was.
