Taking CLE “Down Under”



In Acts 16:9 we read about a call the Apostle Paul received to “come over into Macedonia, and help us.” During the last year, CLE received a similar call from a group of churches in Papua New Guinea (PNG) to come over to the island to help them start Christian schools.

PNG, sometimes referred to as the “last frontier,” is located on part of an island just north of Australia. PNG’s mountainous terrain has kept villages isolated for many years, and its geographic features make travel very difficult. While compulsory education is now a law of the land, in practical terms it is not happening. Therefore, many isolated villages have no schools, or have only private schools that most cannot afford. Young families have a very deep desire to provide an education for their children

that is practical as well as Biblical. Missionaries to PNG from Australia have sensed this need and are trying to help these small community churches set up and operate their own Christian schools.

Jason Kauffman and his family are missionaries in Australia, and he also serves as the distributor for CLE curriculum in Australia. Through his work with CLE, a twenty-foot container of school materials was sent to Australia, with a part of that shipment going on to PNG for these new schools. Included in that shipment were training materials plus curriculum for about 130 students in three communities. The goal was to start three new schools and train the teachers for this first year.

In September of last year Jason Kauffman and Elmer Glick traveled to PNG and conducted a

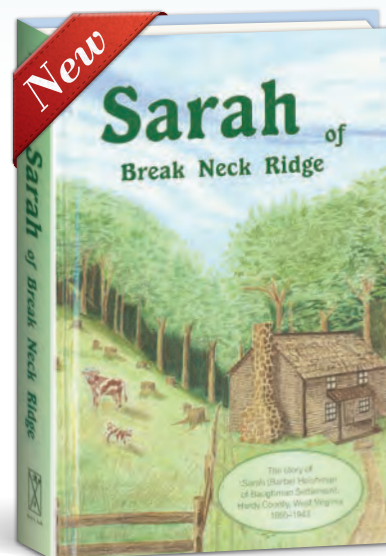

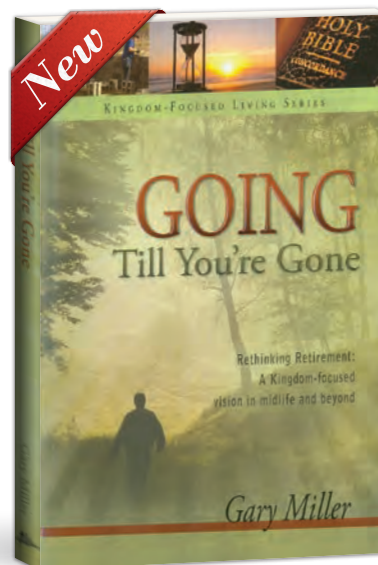


Secret Shadow

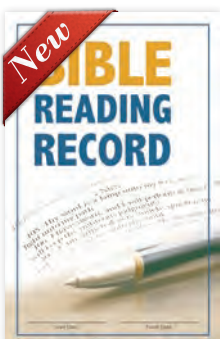
Continued from page 1 » teacher training in the remote village of Kudjip, a few hours' drive from Mt. Hagen in the highlands of PNG. Trainees assembled from various communities—some nine- to ten-hours' drive away. The projected attendance at this training session was 6-8 people, and CLE had sent enough training materials for twelve trainees. Imagine the surprise when 35-40 people showed up for training! But these people were very flexible and the training was conducted with three or four people sharing each training LightUnit!

What is the future for CLE schools in PNG? While the original plan was for three schools, there were representatives at the training from nine communities, each wanting a school. The three schools are planning to begin their new term in February and the others will wait for the next term. Jason Kauffman plans another visit to the areas before the opening of school to give them support and further direction. Beyond that, CLE is keeping the options open for more involvement in PNG as the Lord directs. ■

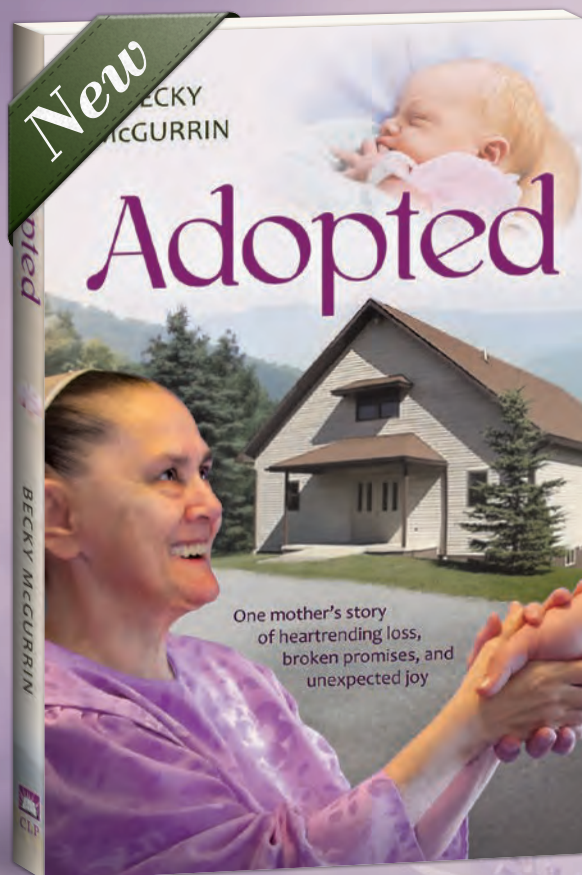
