## Phonics Cards Instructions and Index

The Phonics Cards are a teaching tool to supplement Christian Light Education's phonics, which is taught in Learning to Read, Language Arts levels 100 and 200, and Reading to Learn levels 100 and 200.

The front of each card introduces a phonics rule along with a word and picture illustrating the rule. Several cards display multiple rules with one picture.

The back of each card has words in large print and may be used as a flash card for additional drill of the phonics rule. The words at the bottom are extra words for the teacher to use for further drill on the board or as flash cards.

The number at the top right corner corresponds with the number on the bottom bar on the front of the card. These are used as reference numbers in the teacher's guide to identify which card to use with a lesson, and also to assist with filing in the storage box.

Listed in the top left corner are the LightUnit and lesson numbers where these sounds are introduced in Learning to Read, Language Arts, and Reading to Learn.
