God Knoweth Best

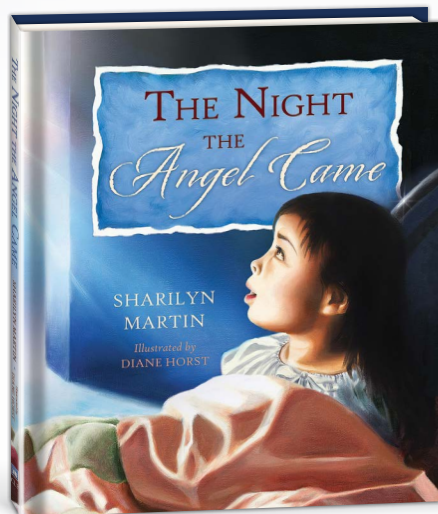
If we could push ajar the gates of life,

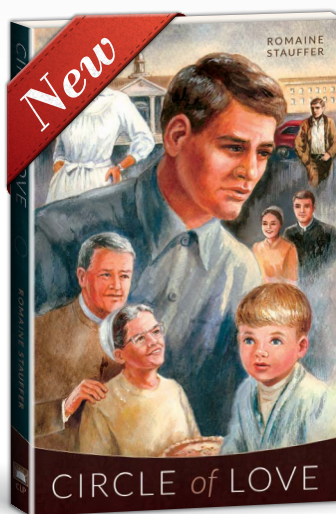


The Night the Angel Came

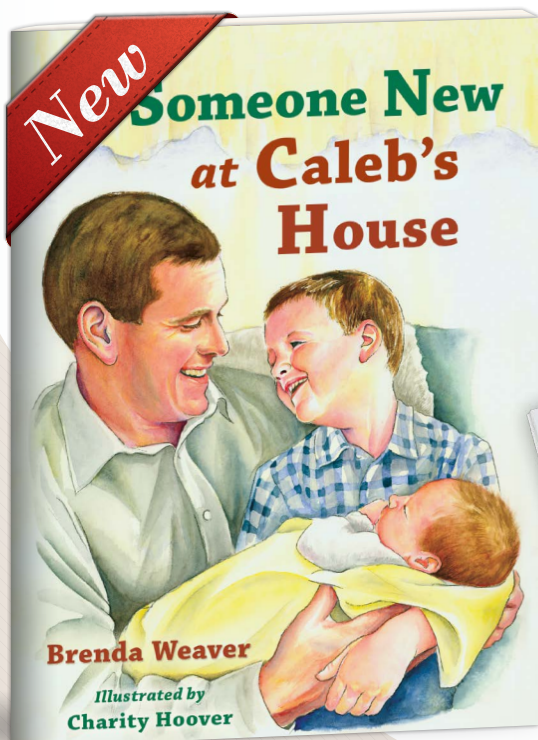
