





Children separate the pages by cutting out the pictures below on the purple lines. Make sure the pages are in the correct order. The one at the top is the last page. Put glue only on the tabs of each page to make a little book. Using the pictures, children tell the teacher the Bible story of Jonah.

Hint: Stick glue works best.
