

Into All the World

On the opposite side of the globe from the Christian Light office in Virginia there is a time zone where the clocks show exactly the same time as our clocks in Virginia. In this time zone lies the country of Malaysia. When the Christian Light office opens at 8:30 a.m., children in Malaysia are going to bed at 8:30 p.m.

Malaysia was once a British colony, and it was during this time that missionaries from the UK brought the Good News of Jesus' kingdom to this primarily Muslim country. The British missionaries started schools and many Malay, Chinese, and Indian parents sent their children to these schools for the sake of a good education. As the Gospel was shared in word and deed, Malaysian young people chose a lifetime of walking with the Saviour.

The British no longer occupy Malaysia, and the British missionary schools are gone. But the children who were impacted are now parents and grandparents, and they want their children to follow the Jesus they love.

Years ago, several families began using Christian Light materials to homeschool their children. Lydia and Eva were sisters using the curriculum, and when their youngest children were in high school, they and their families felt called to start a school. They wanted to share what they had been given, and longed to see God's kingdom grow in their country. Today 150 students are enrolled in their school.

There are now two more schools using the Christian Light curriculum, two in the capital city of Kuala Lumpur, and one in a more mountainous area. These


schools are enrolled in Christian Light's accredited School Support & Record Keeping program, so we keep records and issue diplomas for their students. We visited these schools in May.

What we experienced was a delight. We found the school staff to be incredibly caring, with a clear emphasis on teaching the children about God and providing a high quality academic education. Students and their families are coming to know and walk with the Saviour.

The daily schedule included a devotional and a small group prayer time. Each day a hot lunch was provided, with mixed age groups eating together. Afterwards they cleaned their dishes, the older ones helping the younger.

It's doubtful that Sanford Shank, the founder of Christian Light, had the opposite side of the world in mind when he sensed the call to produce Christian curriculum, but the call came from One who had all this in mind. These Malaysian contacts developed without any marketing efforts on our part. For us, it's a challenge to get books to thousands of students using Christian Light material in Europe, Asia, Australia, and Latin America, but opposite sides of the globe differ nothing to our Lord. And, when we sit down with our brothers and sisters in faraway places, there is an obvious sense of sharing the same Spirit.

Though it stretches us a bit, our Lord seems to be taking Christian Light farther and farther afield. A call to go into "all the world" is still our Saviour's agenda. May His kingdom come and His will be done on earth, as it is in Heaven!




A Teacher for Calvin








Caleb Finds a Friend





SACRIFICE OR PENALTY?

We praise God for the gracious gift of salvation that is ours through Christ. Jesus' death on the cross, a defining moment in making salvation possible, was an event of cosmic magnitude that includes elements we still do not completely understand.

The Bible does give clear teaching on what Jesus did for us by dying on the cross. However, when talking about His death, we may sometimes repeat statements that have implications we have not considered.

- ♦ Jesus paid the penalty for my sin.
- ♦ Jesus took our place and received God's punishment.
- ♦ Jesus suffered the torments of Hell for us.

Where do such statements come from? Do they align with what the Bible teaches about Christ's atonement? Does it matter how we describe Christ's sacrifice on the cross?

This in-depth study of the Scriptures exposes some of the false ideas about salvation permeating churches today. It explores the implications of misunderstanding how Christ's death brings us forgiveness, and calls us back to a simple New Testament understanding of atonement through Christ's sacrifice.
