“God hath spoken once; twice have I heard this; that power belongeth unto God” (Psalms 62:11).

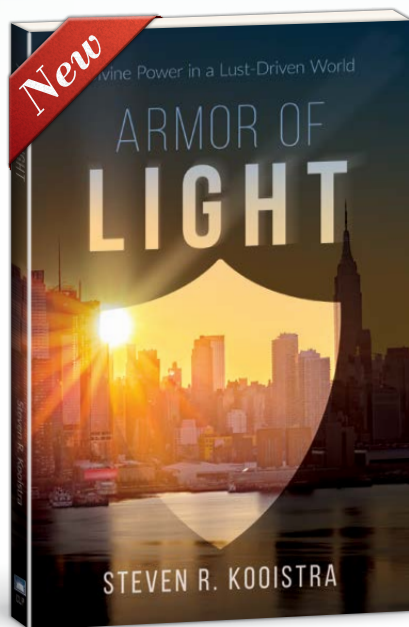

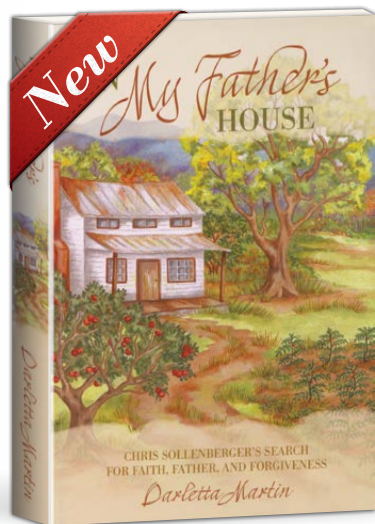


Armor of Light *Steven R. Kooistra*

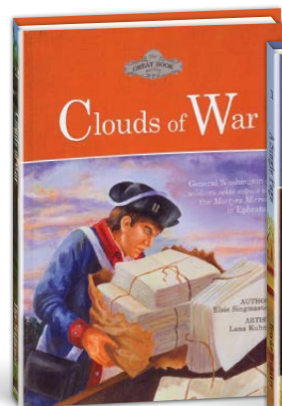

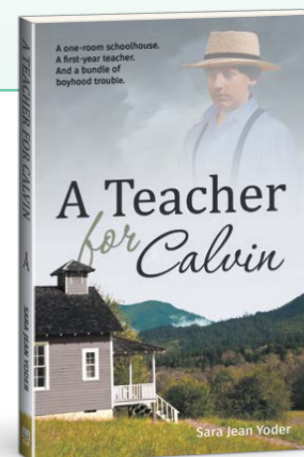
