Fifty Years of Ministry and a change to our name and logo

In the Old Covenant, God designated every fiftieth year as a special year of liberty, a year of Jubilee. This year is a jubilee for Christian Light. Fifty years ago, in 1969, Christian Light Publications was incorporated as a 501(c)(3) ministry.

The vision for Christian Light began with Sanford Shank, a young man who grew up on a farm in the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia. Studying elementary education in college solidified his belief in the necessity of a Christian education. These are his words:

It seems strange that so many people who would support and promote missions are apparently unconcerned when their own children are absorbing ideas that lead away from the truth . . . These children we have brought into the world can go with us into Heaven if they choose the right way . . . If we want our children to be Christians, we must provide Christian training . . . Parents are ultimately responsible. They need to weigh carefully how their children are being influenced at school.

Christian Light's first textbook was published in 1974, a second one in 1976, and the publishing of curriculum and other books has continued nonstop from there. Christian Light's newest textbook, Across the Ages, is being published just this summer, a colorful, engaging history of Western civilization that seventh graders will enjoy using this school term (see page 4). We also published a new Algebra I textbook this year (see page 5).

The many changes, growing pains, and blessings that Christian Light has encountered are too numerous to list. But here are several recent changes we thought you might enjoy hearing about.

While the organization was incorporated as Christian Light Publications (or CLP for short), for decades our curriculum carried the name Christian Light Education (CLE). To eliminate confusion between CLP and CLE and to clarify who we are, from now on we will simply call ourselves Christian Light.

Along with the simplified name, we have adopted a simpler, more vibrant logo.






Fragrance of a Crushed Rose



The textbook has ten units and thirty chapters.




Algebra 1


