

Praying for Others

An important part of prayer is praying for others. Jesus set an example of this for us in John 17. The whole chapter is a prayer for His disciples. Even now He is in Heaven praying for us. Children can learn to follow His example by praying for parents, siblings, friends, and church leaders.

Families can pray for health and healing for others even in a terminal illness because God can heal anyone. We also need to be clear that God doesn't heal everyone, at least not in the way we ask. Sometimes God sends an illness to help us grow nearer to Him or to be a witness to others. Sometimes He may take someone to Heaven for healing.

We all know someone who is running from the Lord. This might seem a hard subject to have children pray about, but we don't have to tell all the details.

We can simply say, "_____ needs our prayers to help him follow Jesus." When we pray for the lost and it seems there is no answer, we can share these truths with our children:

I. Everyone makes their own choices. God never makes anyone follow Him. He just keeps helping them when we pray for them.

2. Sometimes they are choosing right things because of

our prayers, but we can't see this because we aren't around them enough.

3. We must not stop having faith that our prayers make a difference in their lives.

God tells us to pray for the government. We should ask that leaders see what would be God's way and choose the decision God would want. We should pray for their health and safety. God tells us to pray for them so we can serve God peacefully.

Always we need to pray that people will follow Jesus and His Word, make right decisions, and be a witness wherever they are.

"I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; for kings, and for all that

quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth" (I Timothy 2:I-4).

The Fehr Family Series


Life in the Fehr family never seems to be boring. Follow along as they tackle the challenges and adventures of homeschooling, moving, learning how to relate to others, and more.




The Missing Invitation


Let the Little Children Come Christine Diller


Rejoice in Hope Christine Diller








Kay Evans
