

Lodging and Meals

Lodging can be provided in the local area. Notify the Christian Light office or the contact person if you are making your own arrangements or if you require lodging at any training location. Fees include breakfasts and suppers from Monday supper through Friday noon. Additional charges will apply for extra meals and nights. Noon meals are provided for a set fee at the Harrisonburg location. At other locations, the cost for noon meals may be handled differently. Call or email the contact person for further information.

Standards

While we promote loyalty to your church standards and respect the authority of each church and school to set standards, we request observance of the following minimum standards while in training:

- Women are encouraged to wear an appropriate veiling (1 Corinthians 11:1-16).
- Women shall wear dresses with modest (not low) necklines and skirts reaching well below the knees whether sitting or standing.
- Men shall be modestly dressed (with fullbutton shirts) and have short haircuts.
- All shall avoid outward ornamentation, such as jewelry and makeup.
