



IN THE HOME

Teaching your child to read is one of the highlights of home education. But how can you know when your child is ready for this important step? How should you proceed once he is ready? Christian Light's early education program can help you answer these questions.

Beginning with Kindergarten 1, your 4- to 5-year-old can enjoy short periods of pre-reading activities a few times a week. As he matures, the frequency and duration of these lessons can gradually increase.

When you sense that your child is ready to begin studying phonics (typically at 5 to 6 years of age), he can move into Kindergarten 2, which will help prepare him for Christian Light's first-grade program.

Although Learning to Read (and its companion Reading course) were designed to provide enough material for a complete first-grade year, it may be started at the end of Kindergarten if the child is ready. Often Christian Light's first-grade math is also introduced at the same time.

As your child progresses through the Learning to Read and math courses, you


will increase your expectations until he is ready for a full first-grade program including Language Arts and possibly Bible, Social Studies, and Science. By carefully observing your child's progress, you can choose the course that best fits each stage of his early education.

Signs that your child may be ready to begin schooling:

- ◆ Expresses interest in schooling
- ◆ Likes to draw, color, or scribble
- ◆ Respects your authority
- ◆ Follows directions well
- ◆ Likes to be read to for increasing time periods
- ◆ Has a growing attention span

Kindergarten 1

opens the door
to joyful learning.



Kindergarten 1 offers an introduction to basic concepts of learning. Your 4- to 5-year-old can enjoy short periods of pre-reading activities a few times a week. As he matures, the frequency and duration of these lessons can gradually increase. Basic instructions and essential answers are included in the workbooks. The course is divided into thirty lessons with approximately five pages per lesson.

Workbooks

Kindergarten 1 introduces basic concepts of learning. The five workbooks introduce listening skills, matching, identifying eight primary colors, coloring, tracing, counting, and more.

Kindergarten 2

prepares children for Learning to Read.



Kindergarten 2 introduces, but doesn't aim for mastery of, sounds and numbers. Workbooks and Activity Books are to be done simultaneously. The course is divided into thirty lessons. Basic teacher's instructions and essential answers are included in the student books.

Workbooks

The five workbooks specifically prepare students for Christian Light's Learning to Read, but can be used as preparation for any reading program. Workbooks introduce sounds, letters and numbers, letter writing, recognizing and writing numbers 1-100, and more.




Creating a positive atmosphere of learning

- ◆ Keep lessons relaxed and informal in the early years
- ◆ Read to your child often (while cuddled on the couch)
- ◆ Let him make a mess while working, then help clean it up
- ◆ Have lessons when he's most alert (probably right after breakfast)
- ◆ Allow time for creative play
- ◆ Watch for physical discomfort (small legs dangling from a large chair can lose circulation)
- ◆ Be sensitive to the child who has a short attention span
- ◆ Don't pressure your child to meet the expectations of others

A phonics-based program assists the child in mastering words by individual sounds and helps them learn to decode bigger words and use dictionaries in later grades. Learning to Read, Christian Light's phonics reading program, introduces the beginning first grader to the basics of language arts. The lessons cover visual discrimination, listening, handwriting, phonics, spelling, and reading. Other subjects for first grade are coordinated with Learning to Read, which ties together the first-grade curriculum.


LightUnits

Ten LightUnits (workbooks) provide a variety of activities—pictures to color, writing practice, drilling of likenesses and differences, and pictures to identify the consonant or vowel sound. There are also words to sound out and stories to read.

After the 35 basic sounds have been introduced, the lessons generally include a two-page story with questions to answer, a writing page, and a phonics page. The phonics page continues drill—sounding out words, marking vowels—as well as introducing more advanced concepts.

Primers



Flash Cards

A letter card, story, and rhyme are used to introduce the 21 consonants, four consonant digraphs, and long and short vowel sounds. Each full-color picture card illustrates the sound of the letter. The story and rhyme relate to the key picture and contain many words with the new sound. Students learn the rhyme and repeat it frequently to rivet the sound in their minds. The story contains a moral or draws the child's mind to the greatness of God's creation or care for him. Students develop listening comprehension by answering questions about the story.


Word and phrase flash cards are an integral part of the program. Word cards improve word recognition and speed. Phrase cards develop the skill of reading sentences quickly.

Full-color sight word cards help to speed up recognition of sight words taught in Learning to Read.


- ◆ Assemble jigsaw puzzles



Manuscript Alphabet Strip

LightUnits

The LightUnit leads students in a variety of skills. Skills include recalling facts, interpreting simple figures of speech, comparing, predicting, recognizing degrees of importance, listening and speaking, and oral reading skills. Students begin to evaluate what they read; to apply it to everyday situations and to their own lives—in short, to think. Reading 100 requires some teacher involvement because students are still learning to work more on their own.

Christian Light's Language Arts program is built on two key concepts: incremental learning and continuous review. The incremental approach to teaching concepts builds "line upon line, precept upon precept" as each small segment builds on what has already been taught. A new concept is reviewed often—several times before being tested and at regular intervals thereafter—to insure that students remember it.

Phonics: teaches most phonics sounds and spellings

Spelling: phonics review, word meanings

Grammar: nouns, describing words, suffixes, prefixes

Penmanship: all manuscript letters


Creative Writing: thinking, writing, sharing






