Please complete the online International Application for Enrolment. You will need digital copies of the following for uploading:

- ◆ Proof of your child's date of birth, parentage and nationality (i.e. child's Birth Certificate translated into English and Passport)
- ◆ Student Visa, Tourist Visa or Dependant Visa (if already obtained)
- ◆ Recent school reports (translated into English)
- ◆ Results of an acceptable English proficiency test (Years 7-12). Acceptable tests are: IELTS, ISLPR, TOEFL or TOEIC
- ◆ Proof of Overseas Student Health Cover (if already held)
- ◆ Specialists' reports (if applicable).

Enrolment Procedure: If student is in Australia

1. Application for Enrolment completed with \$150 Application Fee received (this is a non-refundable fee to cover pre-enrolment testing and administration costs)
2. Pre-enrolment testing
3. Interview with Head of School, Business Manager and College Principal
4. Letter of Offer and invoice issued
5. Return of signed Letter of Offer and payment of invoice
6. Electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE)
7. Copy of Visa received. OSHC can then be arranged by College (if applicable).

Enrolment Procedure: If student is not in Australia

1. Application for Enrolment completed with \$150 Application Fee received (this is a non-refundable fee to cover pre-enrolment testing and administration costs)
2. Acceptance by Head of School
3. Letter of Offer and invoice issued
4. Return of signed Letter of Offer and payment of invoice
5. Electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE)
6. Copy of Visa received. OSHC can then be arranged by College (if applicable)
7. Testing on arrival in Australia
8. Interview with the Head of School and College Principal.
