The elementary student population has grown dramatically in the 26 years since the last elementary school was built-but our core learning spaces have not.

INCREASE CAPACITY

It's time to add, replace and expand schools to meet critical community needs.

The current number of students in portables can fill two elementary schools.

WHAT'S THE FIX?

BUILD two new elementary schools, REPLACE & EXPAND our oldest elementary schools.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Low interest bonds make money immediately available, while repayment is spread over 20 years.

The overcrowding in the elementary schools is the No.1 issue. Right now we are using 66 portables. For a school district like Peninsula, which is a terrific school system, to have that number of unhoused students is really unheard of.
