Student Health – 3410

The Superintendent will arrange for appropriate and required health services to be provided to all students. Such services shall include but not be limited to:

- A. The maintenance of student health records,
- B. The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill or injured during the school day,
- C. Consulting services of a qualified health specialist,
- D. Vision screening, both near and far, and hearing screening,
- E. Safe administration of required medications,
- F. Immunization compliance-
